

Read to your child for 10 minutes Sing your words to your child instead of saying them Count things you see--ex. cars, trees, flower petals Outline your child's handprints or footprints Play Peek-a-boo or Hide & Seek Play with a flashlight and shadows Trace letters with your child's finger Talk about and remember the day's activities Make up a song with your child's name Talk about the noises animals make Point out your child's nose and other body parts Sing a song, such as, Head & Shoulders, Knees &

Toes, Itsy-Bitsy Spider, or Old MacDonald Point out letters in your child's name Talk with rhyming words Play with blocks or puzzles Read together with your pet Sing a lullaby Roll a ball together Dance or bounce to music Play with a mirror together Drum rhythms on a table Count fingers and toes Talk about animals you see Call Grandma or Grandpa Play with stickers Visit the library Have a picnic

Find shapes around you Blow bubbles with your child Talk about colors around the room Teach your child some sign language Make up a story and tell it to your child Talk about pictures in a book Go to a library program Draw and color with crayons Look at family pictures together Go for a walk Play together with water Make silly noises together Check out books from the library Visit a park




SUMMER READING CLUB JUNE 1—JULY 24 Tadpoles Club, Ages 0-3
